"The Ethics of End of Life Decisions"

Whether it be putting an elderly person in a nursing home on antibiotic or taking an ICU patient off life support, end of life decisions are all around us in our practice. In contemporary Canadian society there is confusion, disagreement & litigation on this difficult question. When conflict emerges it is often as much about who ought to make the decisions as what decisions ought be made.

How can these decisions best be made in as ethical a way as possible & who should make them?

This presentation will review the complex legal & ethical parameters of end of life decision making & propose a model for consideration.

Dr. Kerry Bowman has a Ph.D. in Bioethics, a fellowship in Cultural Psychiatry and a Masters degree in Social Work. Dr. Bowman is the Clinical Ethicist at Mount Sinai Hospital in Toronto, and is also an Assistant Professor in Family and Community Medicine at the University of Toronto Joint Centre for Bioethics.
